



COVID-19 Procedures & Guidelines

Sea Colony Tennis is currently open for modified business. We are socially distancing on and off the court to keep you safe. Please read the procedures and guidelines, listed below, before coming to see us. Thanks!

Pro Shop:

Hours of Operation:

- Open 7 days a week, 8:00 am – 6:00 pm
- Courts are available for social play from 7:30 am – 6:00 pm (call ahead ONLY)
- Lessons are available from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm
- Ball Machine is NOT available

Masks are REQUIRED while inside the Pro Shop, restrooms, hallways, and instances in which physical distancing cannot be accomplished. No mask, no entry.

Please note: the upstairs mezzanine is STAFF ONLY during this time.

At this time the following goods and services are **NOT available**:

- Ball Machine Rental
- Demo Racquets
- Demo Pickleball Paddles
- Borrowing of Tennis Balls

*Racquets, paddles, and balls ARE available for sale in the Pro Shop.

Restrooms:

Restrooms will be cleaned every hour by our housekeeping staff; following all CDC guidelines.

Only one person is allowed in the restroom at a time.

- The designated waiting area will be marked outside the restroom. Patrons must maintain social distancing while waiting to use the restroom.

Before entering restroom

- Make sure your face mask is on, it must be worn at all times.
- Sanitize hands; sanitizer will be provided outside the door.
- Check to make sure the restroom is vacant.

While inside restroom

- Be as brief as possible.
- Limit areas you touch.
- Wash hands in accordance to CDC guidelines:

Exit restroom as soon as possible

- Use a paper towel to open the restroom door when exiting and dispose of paper towel in a receptacle outside of the restroom.
- Sanitize hands again.

Water:

At this time, water will NOT be provided on the indoor or outdoor courts. We do have a **new filtered water station** to fill your reusable water bottle in between points. This touchless station is located in the hallway leading to the clay courts. Please note that the water fountain below is disabled for safety purposes.

Programs:

At this time, we are NOT offering Round Robins, Little Hitters, or Nike Camps. The Novice Clinic is operating under a limited schedule.

Courts:

Outdoors - Every outdoor court is permitted to use. Please be courteous of others when entering and exiting the courts, and wear a mask under all tennis gazebos. You must reserve a court with the front desk. No walk on play is allowed at this time.

Indoors - Play is allowed on every other court. Courts 2, 4, & 6 are currently open. Courts 4 & 6 are open for owner and renter reservations only. No walk on play is allowed at this time. When walking behind the curtains, masks are required.
